ADMISSION PREREQUISITES:

Master’s Degree: All Master’s Degrees or the corresponding Postgraduate Degrees or the corresponding Degrees obtained according to the system prior to Ministerial Decree 509/99 or the corresponding equivalent qualifications.

ADMISSION PROCEDURES:

The selection will be based on the assessment of qualifications, research project (according to the Format 1/F) and oral exam.

During the oral exam, the research project presented by the candidate at the time of the application will also be discussed and the knowledge of the English language will be ascertained.

The assessment will take place pursuant to art. no. 6 and 7 of the Call.

Foreign candidates can choose to take the admission test in English.
