#### **ADMISSION PROCEDURES:**

The selection will be based on the assessment of qualifications, research project (according to the Format 1/I) and oral exam.

The research project, written in English and not exceeding a total of 3,000 words, must include the following sections: 1. *Purpose*; 2. *Originality/Value of the research project*; 3. *Design/Methodological Approach*; 4. *Expected Findings*; 5. *Implications*.

The oral examination will be conducted exclusively online and in English, in order to also assess the candidate's language proficiency. The research project, which must be attached by the applicant to the application form for the aforementioned competition, will be presented and evaluated during the oral examination. Furthermore, upon request by the individual candidate, the oral examination may be conducted in Italian, in which case the assessment of English language proficiency will take place at the end of the interview.

The assessment will take place pursuant to art. no. 6 and 7 of the Call.
